

Getting to Quesnel

By Car

We are connected to many areas of the province by various highway corridors:

- **Highway 97** – connects Quesnel north and south to large cities including Vancouver and Prince George
- **Highway 26** – connects Quesnel east with Wells, Barkerville, and the Bowron Lakes
- **Highway 16** – located one hour north of Quesnel, connecting us east to Jasper and northwest to the Coast
- **Highway 56** – connects Quesnel east with the Nazko Valley

By Plane

Contact [Central Mountain Air](#) and hop on board on one of the 18 weekly flights from Vancouver. Car rentals are available from [Discount Car Rentals](#).

Alternatively, you may choose to fly into Prince George and drive to Quesnel (about an hour drive). Airlines that fly into the Prince George airport are [WestJet](#), [Air Canada](#), [Central Mountain Air](#) and [Pacific Coastal Airlines](#). The Prince George Airport has three rental car agencies conveniently located in the Airport Terminal Building arrivals area – [Budget Rent-a-Car](#), [Hertz Car Rental](#), and [National Car Rentals](#).
