Community Futures' Business and Entrepreneurship Fund provides up to \$5,000 in funding for projects that:

- Support job creation / economic diversification in the North Cariboo region.
- Improve quality of life by making the North Cariboo a better place to live.
- Align with Community Futures Strategic Priorities.
- Provide marketing and promotional opportunities for Community Futures.
- Show investment by the proponent and support from other funders.

Eligible Organizations

Incorporated not-for-profits and Band governments are eligible for funding. For-profit organizations may be eligible where the project intent is to benefit a group of businesses (i.e. sector development).


